


### PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

## St. Julie Billiart Parish

Dear Parishioner

We know that it has been a cold winter when we are glad that it's going up to 32 degrees! Despite the cold, we have much to be grateful for. And knowing that we are blessed, we will have an opportunity to bless others who are less fortunate next weekend. We will be taking up a second collection for the victims of wildfires in California.

Also, next Sunday, February 2<sup>nd</sup>, St. Peter Parish will continue its celebration of its 150th Jubilee Year. There will be a Holy Hour at 3:00 p.m. followed by a potluck dinner. All are welcome to the Holy Hour and if you would like to participate in the potluck dinner, call the St. Peter office (440-327-2201) on or before January 28<sup>th</sup>.

Today our nation begins Catholic Schools week. This gives me an opportunity to mention a couple of things about Catholic Schools. Last year the Diocese of Cleveland began an initiative called Keeping the Faith. Part of this initiative is to make sure that every parish in the Diocese of Cleveland has a vested interest in Catholic Schools. This process is being rolled out over a two-year period. St. Julie Parish has been affiliated with St. Peter School, and we are in the second wave of implementing this initiative. I am expecting to hear from the Diocesan Office of Education and Catechetical Services soon.

The second thing I want to mention is that St. Peter School is having its annual Open House this Sunday, January 26<sup>th</sup>, from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. All are welcome to visit the school and get a taste of what St. Peter School is like. The school motto is: FAITH, Academics, and everything else. I believe this reflects the proper priorities of Catholic education. If you cannot make this Open House, please contact Aimee Reitz, the Administrative Assistant for Mr. Brooks, our principal, at 440-327-3212 to arrange a private tour.

This week St. Peter Parish laid to rest one of its legends. Don Werner passed away at 95 years old. Besides helping with the Men's Breakfast and the Fish Fry, Don and his wife Shiley, (married for 72 years!) sent their seven children to St. Peter School. All seven children have master's degrees or above. I will not attribute all that to St. Peter School. However, our school had a hand in it.

Finally, this is Word of God Sunday. In 2019 Pope Francis designated that the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time be declared Word of God Sunday. This is an opportunity for the Church to emphasize the importance of the Sacred Scriptures in the life of the Church. And today's readings, especially from the Book of Nehemiah, Psalm 19, and the Gospel of Luke, point to the importance of God's word.

### 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

In the Book of Nehemiah, Ezra, a scribe (an expert in the written Word of God), reads and comments on the Sacred Scriptures to the people of God. This event took place a few years after God's people returned from being exiled from their homeland for over 50 years. They were banished from their homeland because of their infidelity to the Word of God. On their return they heard God's word proclaimed to them in a fresh way. They wept with sadness as they understood how far they had fallen from God's ways. Nehemiah and Ezra encouraged them, not to weep, but to rejoice. Though they had fallen far from God, they now know how to rebuild their lives: on the living according to God's word!

Psalm 19 reminds us that the "law of the Lord is perfect, refreshing the soul."

The gospel reading tells us of Luke's methodology. As a true historiographer, Luke gathered the facts and set them out in an orderly fashion. He also records Jesus in the synagogue of his hometown of Nazareth reading the Word of God. He ended his reading by saying something exciting and controversial: this scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing. We will hear about the controversy next week. Right now, let us embrace and live by the Word made Flesh, Jesus Christ!
